Arnold (Arnie) Kenneth Wasserman, 83, of Delray Beach, Florida formerly of Pembroke Pines, passed away on November 16, 2020, after a four-year battle with Lewy Body Dementia. Arnie was born on May 1, 1937 in Bronx, New York to Faye and Eddie Wasserman.

Arnie was a jeweler with tremendous talent and creativity. He began his career in New York City and moved his business to Miami in 1974. S&A Jewelers later moved to a permanent home in Aventura. In 1975, Arnie married his soulmate and wife of 45 years, Carol.
