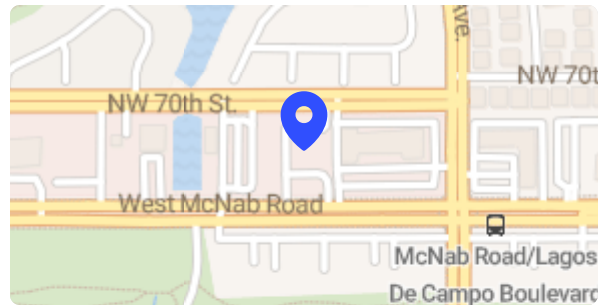

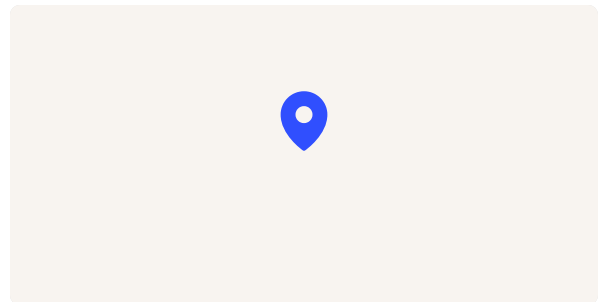

Although you had a hard time understanding when I broke it off with you, I did live and care for you deeply... 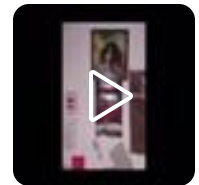
