It is with great sadness we announce the passing of Marsha T. Bierman, age 80.

Marsha's early career was as a secretary to the Miami Dolphins for a period of time, including their legendary undefeated season. She married the love of her life, Lenny Bierman, in 1967, and spent 55 of her happiest years with Lenny by her side. She was preceded in death by him in June, 2022.

From 1986 to 2003 Marsha was a renowned celebrity professional big game angler, developing her stand-up technique for big game fishing. She had numerous sponsors and together she and Lenny spent many years fishing for marlin and conducting stand-up fishing seminars around the globe. Marsha volunteered her time to the Broward County Humane Society, helping animals in need of love and affection.

Marsha is survived by her brother Roger and his wife, Linda.
