A celebration of Laverne's life will be held at a later date. May she rest in eternal peace, forever surrounded by the love she so graciously gave.

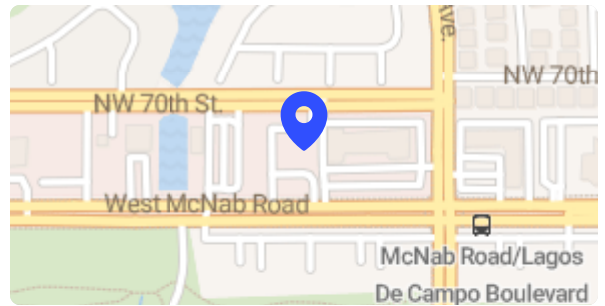
