**I**t is with heavy hearts that we share the passing of Barbara Charitable Poliard, also known to many as Madam Ebel Poliard - a cherished mother, grandmother, and friend.

Barbara passed on November 3rd, 2025, at 10:15 p.m. after 22 years of illness surrounded by the loving care of her children, notably her daughter Ermione who accompanied her through every stage.

Barbara was born in Anse-a-Foleur on June 3rd 1937, in the northwest region of Haiti, the second of eight children. In 1980, along with her children, she immigrated to Broward, Florida.

After moving to the States, Barbara worked with Holiday Inn before joining West Side Hospital, where she was employed for over 12 years. 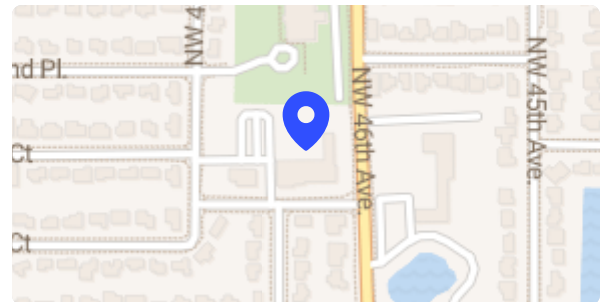

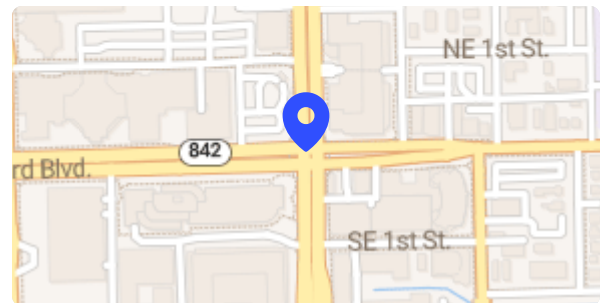

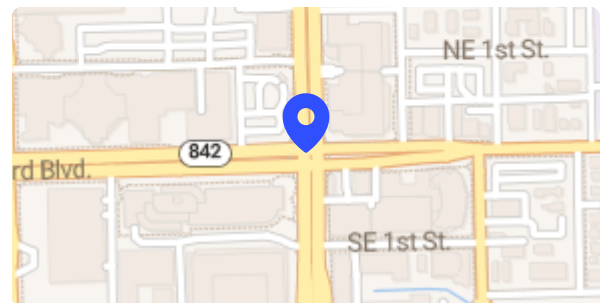
